01/ At the outset, the Registrar announced that in the absence of the Chancellor and the Pro-Chancellor, the Vice-Chancellor would preside over the meeting of the Court in terms of provisions of Clause 4 (iii) of the Regulations for the conduct of the meeting of the Court. Accordingly, the Vice-Chancellor took the Chair. Further, the Registrar read out the following welcome note for the Prof. Yogesh Kumar Tyagi, Vice-Chancellor, University of Delhi:

On behalf of all the members of the University Court and on my behalf, I extend a very warm welcome to Prof. Yogesh Kumar Tyagi on his taking charge as the 22nd Vice-Chancellor of this prestigious University.

It is indeed an honour to inform the Court that the Hon'ble President of India, in his capacity as the Visitor of the University of Delhi has in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Statute 11-F of the Statutes of the University, pleased to appoint Professor Yogesh Tyagi, as the Vice-Chancellor of the University, as communicated vide letter dated 15th February, 2016 of the Ministry of Human Resource Development of the Government of India. Professor Yogesh Tyagi has assumed the Office of the Vice-Chancellor on 10th March, 2016.

Professor Yogesh Tyagi has joined as the 22nd Vice-Chancellor of the University of Delhi on 10th March, 2016. Professor Yogesh Tyagi received his LL.M. from the Columbia University School of Law in New York, where he was a Silver Fellow and subsequently a Fulbright Scholar. He completed his M.Phil. and Ph.D. at Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU). He was Dean of the Faculty of Legal Studies, South Asian University (SAU). Earlier, he was Dean of the School of International Studies at JNU and also Professor of Law at the City University of Hong Kong.

Professor Tyagi is a Member of the *l'Institut de Droit International*. He has served as Member of the Law Commission of India; Director of the Centre for Studies and Research in International Law and International Relations, The Hague Academy of International Law, The Netherlands, 2015 (the English-speaking section); and Co-Chair of the Research and Planning Committee of the Asian Society of International Law.

Professor Tyagi has held Visiting appointments at the London School of Economics and Political Science, the University of Tokyo, the University of Georgia at Athens, the Max Planck Institute for Comparative and International Law, and many other institutions worldwide. He has published in international periodicals, including the *British Year Book of International Law*, the *Cambridge Journal of International and Comparative Law*, the *Michigan Journal of Internal Law*, the *Texas International Law Journal*, and the *Journal of World Trade*.

Professor Tyagi has special interest in International Law, Law of International Organization, Human Rights Law, Legal Theory, and Globalization.

Prof. K.N. Sharma

Prof. K.N. Sharma from Department of Physiology at University College of Medical Sciences passed away on **21st June, 2015**.

Prof. Sharma was appointed Head of Department of Physiology in 1976 and Principal of University College of Medical Sciences in 1981. He served for approximately 18 years at University College of Medical Sciences. He also served as Project Consultant in a joint project of Government of India and Nepal to plan and develop B.P. Koirala Institute of Health Sciences, Dharan, Nepal. He was compassionate and kind and well-liked by his colleagues and students.

Prof. Manabendra Adhikary

Prof. Manabendra Adhikary, former Head and Dean, Faculty of Management Studies, and former Proctor, University of Delhi passed away on **25th September, 2015**.

He studied M.A. in Economics from Delhi School of Economics and taught at St Stephen's College, amongst others before moving to Indiana University, USA to pursue his Ph.D. He joined FMS in 1974. He was the Founder Director of New Delhi Institute of Management, affiliated to Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University. He authored several articles and books in the areas of Managerial Economics and General Management.

Prof. B.S. Sharma

We note the sad demise of Prof. Bheem Sain Sharma, former Head and Dean, Faculty of Management Studies on 14th December, 2015.

Prof Sharma did his Masters in Economics and Ph.D. in Finance from University of Jodhpur. He began his career as a Lecturer in University of Jodhpur. He joined FMS in 1970 and retired in 1999. He also served as the Pro Vice Chancellor of Indira Gandhi National Open University and the Vice-Chancellor of Kota Open University. He authored several books and papers and supervised over 20 Ph.D. students.

Prof. Harish C. Gaur

We record with sorrow the passing away of Prof. Harish C. Gaur, former Head, Department of Chemistry and Dean, Faculty of Sciences on 14th December, 2015.

Prof Gaur completed his Ph.D. and Doctorate of Science from University of Illinois, Urbana, USA. He joined the University of Delhi as Lecturer in 1951 and was promoted to Professor in 1973. His works in Electrochemistry took him to NASA, USA. He was a member of the Academic and Executive Council of the University of Delhi. He was also on the Governing Body of several colleges.

Prof. J.L. Sardana

We note with sorrow the sad demise of Prof. J.L. Sardana from the Department of Library and Information Sciences on 25th February, 2016.

Prof. J.L. Sardana joined as Professor in the Department on 12th February, 1987. He taught undergraduate and Masters students and also supervised M.Phil. as well as Ph.D. research scholars of the Department. He served the University for almost 12 years before retiring in the year 1999.

Prof. J.D. Mehra

Prof. J.D. Mehra, former Head, Department of Anthropology passed away on 30th July, 2016.

Prof. J.D. Mehra was born on 5th January, 1924. He did his Masters and Ph.D from the University of Delhi. He was appointed as a Lecturer in 1953 and Professor in Anthropology in 1977. He was Head of the Department of Anthropology from 1979 to 1981 and retired in 1989. He published nearly 30 research papers and participated in many conferences and National Congress meetings.

Prof. Indera Paul Singh

Prof. Indera Paul Singh, former Head, Department of Anthropology and Dean, Faculty of Science passed away on 27th September, 2016.

He completed his Ph.D in Anthropology in 1959 from University of Delhi. He joined the Department of Anthropology as a Lecturer in 1953, became a Professor in 1971. He was the Head of the Department of Anthropology from 1968 to 1979 and 1981 to 1984. Prof. Singh also served as the Dean of the Faculty of Science from 1971-73, 1973-75 and 1983-84. He was also the Proctor of the University of Delhi from 1973 to 1992. He was also the Chairman of the Delhi University Sports Council from 1981-93.

Prof. Shamim Nikhat

We report the sad demise of Prof. Shamim Nikhat, former Head of the Department of Urdu, University of Delhi on **28th September, 2016**.

Prof. Nikhat was born on 10th October, 1935. He joined the University of Delhi as Lecturer on 16th July, 1963. He was promoted to Professor in 1993 and served as Head of the Department in the same year. He retired in the year 2000.

In the death of Prof. Shamim Nikhat, we have lost a dedicated teacher and writer.

Prof. M.C. Kapoor

We place on record our deep sorrow on the sad demise of Prof. M.C. Kapoor from the Faculty of Commerce and Business on **29th September, 2016**.

The demise of Prof. M.C. Kapoor has left a deep vacuum both for academicians and civil society. In his demise, the Department and the University have lost a good scholar and teacher as well as a great human being.

Prof. Sughan Bhatia

We note with sorrow the sad demise of Prof. Sughan Bhatia on **26th November, 2016**.

Prof. Sughan Bhatia joined as a Lecturer in English in 1972 in a college in the University of Delhi. He joined the Adult and Continuing Education Cell as its Coordinator in 1979 and became its Director in 1982. He retired in 2005 after completing 38 years of service in the University of Delhi. He was a member of various committees of the University Grants Commission that helped set up more than 100 Departments of Adult, Continuing Education and Extension in Universities in India.

Prof. Rajendra Singh

Prof. Rajendra Singh, former Head of Department of Social Work passed away on **27th November, 2016**.

Prof. Rajendra Singh was a renowned sociologist. He was a very learned scholar and teacher, and an avid researcher especially in the field of Sociology of Social Movements. He published three books. His book titled 'Social Movements, Old and New' was very well received. He was the Head of the Department from 1996 to 1997 and initiated many changes within the curriculum. He also guided five PhD research scholars.

Prof. S. Nath

Prof. S.Nath, former Head of Department of Anthropology and Dean, Faculty of Science passed away on **16th December, 2016**.

Prof. S. Nath completed his undergraduate, Masters and PhD degree from the University of Delhi. He was appointed Lecturer in 1978 and Professor in 1995. He served as Head and Dean from 2004-2007. He guided several M.Phil and PhD research scholars in Anthropology. Prof Nath retired from the University in September 2010.

Prof. Krishan Lal

We report the sad demise of Prof. Krishan Lal, former Head, Department of Sanskrit on **18th December, 2016.**

He started his teaching career from PGDAV College, where he taught from 1957 to 1972. He joined the Department of Sanskrit, University of Delhi in 1972 as Reader and became Professor in 1983. He served the Department as Head from 1989 to 1992 and retired from his services in 1995. Prof. Krishan Lal was well known for his work in the area of Vedic studies. He also contributed immensely as a poet, novelist and a story writer in both Sanskrit and Hindi. He received several awards including the 'Rashtrapati Samman' by the President of India.

Prof. V.S. Minocha

We note with sorrow the sad demise of Prof. V.S. Minocha on **23rd January, 2017.**

Prof. V.S. Minocha was former Head of the Department of Commerce and Dean of the Faculty of Commerce and Business during 1994 and 1995. He taught Economics of Business Growth, besides other courses. In his demise, we have lost a great scholar and dedicated teacher.

Justice Altamas Kabir

Justice Altamas Kabir, Former Chief Justice of India and Pro Chancellor of the University of Delhi, passed away on **19th February, 2017.**

Justice Kabir completed his LL.B. and M.A. from the University of Calcutta. He was appointed a permanent judge in the Calcutta High Court in 1990 and Chief Justice of the Jharkhand High Court in 2005.

He was appointed the 39th Chief Justice of India in 2012 and retired in July, 2013 after a brief tenure of about nine months. Justice Kabir delivered several landmark judgments particularly on human rights and election laws during his tenure as Chief Justice.

Prof. Parmanand Singh

Prof. Parmanand Singh, former Dean, Faculty of Law left for heavenly abode on **20th February, 2017.**

Prof Parmanand Singh joined the Faculty of Law in 1971 and retired in July, 2006. He was the Dean, Faculty of Law from 2001-2003. Before joining University of Delhi, Prof. Singh taught at Banaras Hindu University and University of Gorakhpur. He had several visiting assignments at various reputed Universities abroad including Max Planck Institute, Heidelberg, Germany, Wasada University, Tokyo, Kansai University, Osaka, Tribhuvan University, Kathmandu, Institute of Advanced Study, Berlin.

Prof. Basudev Chatterji

Eminent historian, Prof. Basudev Chatterji passed away on **09th June, 2017**.

Prof. B.D. Chatterji did his undergraduate and Masters studies from University of Delhi and Ph.D from Cambridge University in 1978. He taught at St. Stephen's College, Department of History, University of Delhi and Hyderabad University. Prof. Chatterji was the 20th Chairperson of the Indian Council of Historical Research. His research on the economic history of modern India was extremely well received.

In his demise, we have lost an accomplished researcher and scholar.

Dr. Biswamoy Pati

Placement Activities

Leading organizations of international and national repute partnered with University of Delhi for recruitment and internships through the Central Placement Cell. More than 35 companies conducted on-Campus Selection Drives at both North and South Campus. Around 1100 students were placed in various organizations in the public and private sector.

Skill Enhancement Initiatives

The University is actively involved in creating skilled manpower at various levels under the scheme Deen Dayal Upadhyay Centres for "Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood (KAUSHAL)".

Social Outreach

The University is also committed to its Social Outreach initiatives. It has set up a Community Development Cell, under which the University has adopted five villages -Jagatpur Shahdra, Jharoda Majara Burari, Mukundpur, Badarpur Khadar and Bakiabad. Initiatives include efforts towards augmentation in the basic infrastructure related to transport, water, sanitation and work towards addressing problems relating to sanitation and waste management; creation of sustainable health services through the establishment of Mohalla Clinics and mobile van; organisation of regular health camps. The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is another initiative that is working towards comprehensive rural community development.

Participation of students in Olympics

Three students of University of Delhi Colleges were selected for participating in 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.
