Advice

- Utmost care must be exercised in submitting Personal details, Social Category, Caste and Gender. Once submitted, these cannot be changed.
- Utmost care should be taken while filling Class XII marks as these will be the basis of breaking the merit tie, if any.
- Ensure all relevant documents are valid and in the prescribed format.
- UoD will not entertain any undertaking in lieu of incomplete/non-availability of certificates/documents.
- Fill the form well before the deadline and do not be in haste while filling the form.

CONFIRMING THE PREFERENCES

Candidates will have to confirm their preferences. If not confirmed till the last date, his/her last saved preference order will be locked automatically and will become the basis of allocation of seats for such a candidate.

Advice for Giving Program + College Preferences

- Select as many Programs as possible subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria.
- Fill maximum number of preferences.
- Arrange the preference order of Program + College very carefully.
 Preferences cannot be modified at later stage.
- Read UG Bulletin of Information thoroughly and then confirm your preferences of Program + College, before the deadline of the Preference-Filling phase.
- Start Filling the CSAS-2022 early. Do not be in haste while selecting Programs.
- Do not wait for the last date of Preference filling.

Phase III: Seat Allocation and Admission




Highest Possible Preference will be provisionally allocated to a candidate considering the following criteria:

- a. Program-Group merit list (Programs with the same Program-Specific Eligibility Criteria make a Program-Group).
- b. Category (UR/OBC-NCL/SC/ST/EWS/Minority/PwBD/KM/CW).
- c. Availability of seats.

Allocation - Admission





Important: In order to be considered for upgradation in the subsequent rounds a candidate <u>must "Accept"</u> the allocated seat.


Acceptance of the provisionally allocated seat

Non-Acceptance of the allocated seat-

- No action/ inactivity will be taken as non-acceptance to the Allocated Seat will be treated as a decline to the provisional offer of an Allocated Seat.
- Candidate will no longer be able to participate in the subsequent rounds of CSAS-2022

Online Approval by the College






The College will check the eligibility and verify documents of the candidate.

- College shall "Approve" or "Reject".
- If approved, Pay the "Admission Fee" and confirm the admission on the allocated seat.

Upgrade And Freeze Options





- Admitted candidate may choose 'Upgrade' option to try for their higher submitted preferences than the current allocated one.
- If the higher preference is allocated, candidate will have to accept new allocated seat.

Admission 'Freeze' Option



• If a candidate desire to continue the existing admission, he/she should submit a 'Freeze' request through his/her dashboard.

 If a candidate is satisfied with his/her current admission and chooses 'Freeze' option, he/she will never be allowed to opt for "Upgradation".

• If an admitted candidate neither opts for upgradation nor opts for freeze, and remains inactive, then the admission taken by him/her will be retained and he/she will not be considered for upgradation.

Tie-Breaking Rules



- 1. Higher percentage of aggregate marks in the Best 3 subjects of Class XII
- 2. Higher percentage of aggregate marks in the Best 4 subjects of Class XII
- 3. Higher percentage of aggregate marks in the Best 5 subjects of Class XII
- 4. Age of the candidate

Online Query Resolution System

A facility has been provided during the Approvals for Colleges to raise queries and seek clarification from the candidates, if need be

Mid-Entry

- If a candidate failed to apply for CSAS-2022 within the stipulated time and is desirous of participating later, can do so through the Mid-Entry window (whenever University announces it), by paying a Mid-Entry fee of Rs. 1000.00 (non-refundable).
- Mid-Entrants will not hold any right to claim the seats allocated to candidates. They will be considered for allocation only after all the candidates who had applied earlier and have the merit score/s higher than the lowest declared score have been given allocated.
- It is therefore, advisable to apply within the stipulated Application Phase



Spot Admission Rounds

- To fill the vacant seats, Spot round/s may be announced.
- Candidates who were not admitted to any College on the date of declaration of the Spot Admission round can participate.
- Candidate will have to opt for 'Spot Admission' through his/her dashboard.
- For every Spot Admission round the University will display the vacant seats of each Program. A desirous candidate will be able to select ONLY ONE Program.

Allocation Criteria:

- 1. Availability of seats.
- 2. Program-Specific merit.
- 3. Order of Preference of College.
- 4. Category.



Additional Allocations in First Round Allocation

- To facilitate faster allocation-cum-admission process, in the **First Round of Allocation**:
- 20% extra allocations for each program in each college under UR/OBC-NCL/EWS categories.
- 30% extra allocations for each program in each college under SC/ST/PwBD categories.

ECA Categories and Rules

- There are 14 ECA Categories further divided into sub-categories. A candidate can apply for a maximum of 3 ECA categories.
- For each ECA category, s(he) must upload a maximum of Best Five certificates issued between 1st April 2017 30th June 2022.
- Out of these five, the candidates shall be marked on the basis of three best certificates only, as per the Certificate-Marking criteria.

ECA Allocation Policy

Allocation will be offered on the basis of Combined ECA Merit (CEM):

25% of the highest Program-Specific CUET percentage score of all the Programs in which s(he) has applied &

75% of the highest ECA score obtained from all the ECA categories in which s(he) has been considered.

To be considered in an ECA category, the candidate must have scored a minimum of 30 marks out of 75 ECA Score

Admission on Sports Supernumerary Quota



- 27 Games/Sports for Women and 26 Games/Sports for Men in different Colleges.
- Combined Sports Merit (CSM):
 - 25% of the highest Program-Specific CUET percentage score of all the Programs in which s(he) has applied.
 - 25% of the highest graded Merit/Participation Sports Certificate.
 - 50% of the highest score obtained in the Sports Trials in which s(he) appears.

Eligibility for CSM:

Minimum of 20/200 Marks in Sports Certificate; and

Minimum of 200/400 marks in Sports Trial.

Merit/Participation Sports Certificate issued from 1st April 2017 to 30th June 2022 will be considered.

Admissions on Supernumerary Seats.





