The Vice-Chancellor briefed the Council that the special meeting was convened for considering the syllabi of semester based courses which are to be implemented from the academic session 2010-2011. Some of the elected members wanted to reopen the issue of desirability and feasibility of the semester system in under graduate courses. The Vice-Chancellor repeatedly informed the Council that the resolution for implementation of the semester system in under graduate courses from academic session 2010-2011 has already been approved by the Academic Council vide its Resolution No.10 dated 5.6.2009. The elected members of the Council started debate on the issue which continued for many hours.

The Vice-Chancellor repeatedly requested the members to take up the agenda for consideration, but some of the members started disrupting the proceedings. Despite repeated pleas made by the Vice-Chancellor, some members of the Academic Council continued to disturb the meeting.

The recommendations of the Standing Committee on Academic Matters of the Academic Council in its meeting held on 11.05.2010 were, however, considered and resolved as follows:

21. Resolved that the recommendations of the Faculty of Science made at its meeting held on 22.06.2009 regarding introduction of Post-Graduate **Diploma in Health and Social Gerontology** at the Institute of Home Economics be accepted and recommended to the Academic Council for approval (vide Appendix-XVIII).

Further resolved that the consequential amendments/ additions/ modifications, if any, be made in the Ordinances.

22. Resolved that the following recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor to frame common pass and promotion rules for semester based Under Graduate courses be accepted and recommended to the Academic Council for approval.

#### 1. Scheme of Examination:

- 1.1 Examinations shall be conducted at the end of each Semester as per the Academic Calendar notified by the University of Delhi.
- 1.2 Each course will carry two components: Internal Assessment and End-Semester Examination.

# 2. Pass Percentage & Promotion Criteria

2.1. The minimum marks required to pass any paper in a semester shall be 40% in theory and 40% in Practical, wherever applicable. The student must secure 40% in the End Semester Examination and 40% in the total of End Semester Examination & Internal Assessment of the paper for both theory & practical separately.

- 2.2 A student shall be eligible for promotion from Ist year to IInd year of the course provided she/he has passed 50% papers of I and II Semester taken together.
- 2.3 Similarly, a student (irrespective of Part I results) shall be eligible for promotion from IInd year to IIIrd year of the course provided she/he has passed 50% papers of III and IV Semesters taken together.
- 2.4 Students who do not fulfill the promotion criteria 2.2 & 2.3 above shall be declared failed in the Part concerned. However, they shall have the option to retain the marks in the papers in which they have secured Pass marks as per Clause 2.1 above.
- 2.5 A student who has to reappear in a paper prescribed for Semester I/III/ V may do so only in the Semester examinations to be held in November/December. A student who has to reappear in a paper prescribed for Semester II/IV/VI may do so only in the examination to be held in April/May.

#### 3. Reappearance in passed papers:

- 3.1 A student may reappear in any theory paper prescribed for a semester, on foregoing in writing her/his previous performance in the paper/s concerned. This can be done in the immediate subsequent semester examination only (for example, a student reappearing in a paper prescribed for Semester I examination, may do so along with subsequent Semester III examination and not along with papers for Semester V).
- 3.2 A candidate who has cleared the papers of Part III (V &VI Semesters) may reappear in any paper of V or VI Semester only once, at the immediate subsequent examination on foregoing in writing her/his previous performance in the paper/s concerned, within the prescribed span period.

  (Note: The candidate of this category will not be allowed to join any postgraduate courses)
- 3.3 In the case of reappearance in a paper, the result will be prepared on the basis of candidate's current performance in the examination.
- 3.4 In the case of a candidate, who opts to re-appear in any paper/s under the aforesaid provisions, on surrendering her/his earlier performance but fails to re-appear in the paper/s concerned, the marks previously secured by the candidate in the paper/s in which she/he has failed to re-appear shall be taken into account while determining her/his result of the examination held currently.
- 3.5 Reappearance in Practical examinations shall not be allowed.
- 3.6 A student who reappears in a paper shall carry forward the internal assessment marks, originally awarded.

#### 4. **Division Criteria:**

A student who passes all the papers prescribed for Semester I to Semester VI examinations would be eligible for the degree. Such a student shall be categorized on the basis of the combined result of Semester I to Semester VI examinations as follows:-

60% or more First Division
50% or more but less than 60% Second Division
40% or more but less than 50% Third Division

## 5. **Supplementary Examinations:**

There shall be no Supplementary examinations for any Undergraduate Courses.

## 6. **Span Period:**

The span period to complete the course shall be six years from the year of admission in the Ist Semester.

# 7. Failed Students:

Failed students shall appear in the examination as per rules prescribed for exstudents.

Further resolved that the consequential amendments/ additions/ modifications, if any, be made in the Ordinances.
