#### ANY OTHER MATTER

56/ The Academic Council considered the issue of permission granted by DDA for the construction of a high rise residential complex (4 blocks of 35 floors each) that is proposed to be built in the North Campus of the University of Delhi in the parking lot of Viswavidyalaya Metro Station and resolved as follows:

"The Academic Council expresses its deep concern and outrage at the multistoreyed residential complex proposed to be constructed in seeming disregard of civic and other regulatory norms that apply to the area of the parking facility of the Delhi Viswavidyalaya Metro Station, which is integral to the North Campus of the University of Delhi. Such a proposed construction meant for the upper echelons of society comprising of four towers of 35 floor structures each is bound to create havoc with the environment and sociocultural harmony of the University of Delhi campus. The Council appeals to the Chancellor to intervene in the matter on urgent basis.
