## Ordinance IX Clause 12:

Sub Clause: 3 (a) Letter Grades and Grade Points

The results for all the Undergraduate courses under the CBCS shall be based on a 10 point grading system with Letter Grades as per the formula prescribed by the University Grants Commission as at **Table 'A**' below:

## AMENDMENTS PROPOSED

The results for the all the Undergraduate courses under the CBCS shall be based on a 10 point grading system with Letter Grades as per the formula prescribed by the University Grants Commission with minor changes in the computation of the grade cut offs as at Table 'B' below:

Sub Clause 12 (1)(b):  A student who has obtained 40% on the aggregate taking together all the papers in theory examination (including internal assessment /project work) and practical examination separately conducted in 1st and 1Ind semester shall be promoted to the second academic year/IIIrd semester  Sub Clause 12 (1)(c):  A student who has obtained 40% on the aggregate taking together all the papers in theory examination (including internal assessment /project work) and practical	value is therefore to be 'deleted'.  Promotion Rules:  A student shall be eligible for promotion from 1st year to 2nd year/III semester provided he/she has passed 50% papers of I and II semester taken together and similarly for promotion from 2nd year to 3rd year/V
