

Before granting Examination Centre, the University Examination Branch must ensure a proper orientation of the Superintendent, Deputy Superintendent and Invigilators about the procedure to be followed while making an UFM case so that the future of examinee is not compromised. With regard to the two Centres of candidates at Sl.No.5 and 8 i.e. S.K.V. Soami Nagar, Chirag Delhi, New Delhi-110017 and Shaheed Udham Singh Public School, Shastri Nagar, A-Block, Near Gulabi Bagh, Delhi-110052, the Examination Wing must examine the credentials carefully and thoroughly and take action accordingly so as not to tarnish the image of our prestigious University.
